Design Narrative – Option 1

Our first design option creates a play area near the parking lot within the existing sidewalk boundaries. We are offering an option to either build above or below grade depending on your preferences. The general design consists of 45' diameter play area with a Burke Aspire Tower structure. The design includes an ADA transfer station with access to multiple slides & climbers with access to a 14' tall deck via a rope tunnel, which will providep a great vantage point to check out the park. At ground level we have numerous play panels, balancing events and climbers.

We are also including six Burke Swinging benches to place around the park which are available in over 26 powder coat colors bringing a fun swinging experience to the rest of the park. We can install them inground on the grass or surface mount them on concrete pads. We are also happy to provide plaque's if you want to have people sponsor each swinging bench.

TASK ONE – PLAYGROUND CONCEPT DEVELOPMENT

Owner is responsible for any private locates required and marking all other utilities, irrigation, and drainage/sewer system components. Customer agrees that we are not liable for any damage done to any type of underground utilities, including but not limited to sewer, electrical, telecommunications, or landscaping sprinkler lines/heads on the site chosen by the customer.
- MOBILIZATIONS Price assumes all work to be done at one time unless otherwise stated, additional mobilizations will have additional charges.

Surfacing

- · Playground surfacing should be installed after all equipment is installed or additional charges will apply.
- <u>EXCLUSIONS</u> Unless specifically listed, pricing does not include drainage, stone, asphalt or concrete work, curb work.
- <u>EWF SURFACING</u> Costs for Installation by Blower Truck are predicated on the ability to deliver product with blower truck from reasonable distance (~less than 500' from final install point) and are for single drops. Additional drops to be priced per location.
- <u>TURE SURFACING</u> Prior to our arrival, the site must have the sub-base properly graded and compacted with proper drainage installed, and photographs of the site are required to confirm site readiness. Any disturbance to turf after installation by the customer, or any drainage issues caused by the installation, will cause product warranties to immediately become VOID.

Shade

- <u>FOOTINGS</u> At this stage, we can only provide an ESTIMATED footing size. The ACTUAL required footing size and steel reinforcing for this project can only be determined within the engineering process. We are including our closest size suggestion and this should be used for budget and quoting purposes only and SHOULD NOT be used for actual digging and pouring of footings for the project. Additional costs for footings may be required once engineering is completed.
- ENGINEERING Sealed Engineered Drawing and Calculation fees are non-refundable and will be collected at time of order in addition to any down payment required.
- <u>PERMITS</u> Unless specifically listed, customer is responsible for all permits. Our installer cannot begin footings until your permits are approved. If our installer is completing the permit process for you, we will complete Engineering and the Permit process **BEFORE** manufacturing begins.



Safety Standards & Guidelines - Reference Information

The Konnection Swing was designed to provide an intergenerational play opportunity and offer everyone the childhood joy of swinging! While researching the use of swings, two trends stood out to us - caregivers pushing infants in bucket seat swings and adults swinging with children on their lap. Both situations could be improved with the design of a swing designed to foster connection and increase safety. The Konnection Swing was developed as a direct result of this. The overall design is focused on fostering true connection in both eye contact and proximity leading to increased engagement for all users. Hands-free swinging allows the caregiver to hold, interact and play with the child as they both experience the thrill of swinging together.

The Konnection Swing is IPEMA Certified and meets or exceeds the requirements of ASTM F1487-17, which is recognized as the standard of care in the playground industry. This ASTM public playground safety standard is revised every two to three years to remain current with innovation and market trends.

The CPSC Public Playground Safety Handbook hasn't been revised since 2008 and doesn't include new product categories that have been innovated in recent years. There are a couple of points to note when deciding to purchase a multi-user swing:

- Multi-user swings are innovative and CPSC Public Playground Safety Handbook doesn't have a standard that specifically covers them.
- CPSC 5.3.8.3.1 CPSC recommends that belt swing seats should be designed to accommodate no more than one user at any time. While the Konnection Swing is a single axis swing, it is clearly not a belt seat.
- CPSC 2.3.1 CPSC says that swings intended for more than one user are not recommended because their greater mass, as compared to single occupancy swings, presents a risk of impact injury.
- The ASTM safety standard, F1487, was revised in 2011 to add maximum impact requirements for swings and the Konnection Swing has been tested and is compliant with ASTM impact requirements.
- CPSC has written a letter stating that "the swing impact test in F1487-11 is a reasonable approach to address the concerns posed by unoccupied, heavy, multiple occupancy swings."
- CPSC has always included an exemption to both recommendations listed above for tire swings, which are multiple occupancy swings that are suspended from a single pivot and permit swinging in any direction.
- CPSC also emphasizes that their Handbook provides recommendations, not requirements. If a jurisdiction adopts the Handbook's recommendations as mandatory requirements, that jurisdiction would need to determine how the requirements should be applied in any particular instance.







Design Summary

Option A - Futuristic Climbers!

For Option A, we designed using equipment from Berliner. Rope play is their bread and butter, and it is fun!

Welcome to the helical DNA Tower! For the main feature we included a tall DNA Tower structure with an awesome 9' tube slide. This structure is from Berliner's Univers Line. The DNA Towers are graceful towers containing three-dimensional climbing nets stretched inside external steel skeletons. A careful combination of curved and straight metal tubing results in a spiral resembling the structure of DNA.

This impression is further enhanced by chosen color schemes, as well as the use of differing thicknesses of tubing. The DNA Towers have been deliberately designed to give an open and unencumbered feel. This one also includes a Duck Jibe for spinning fun.

For the younger park visitors we have also included a modified Spoo Roo Combi with a fast lane slide. This is an engaging combination of two spooky houses connected by a rope suspension bridge. The kids will love moving between the two house, and they each offer some shade for the playground.

And finally we chose the Orbit.01 for a balancing challenge.

This Berliner playground fits this unique play area perfectly, and will be an amazing addition to Roxborough Community Park.














2D Renderings/Site Plan - Option A

Design Summary

Option B - Natural Fun!

For Option B, we designed with our Earthscape Collections line. We included the Timber Tower 2, which stands an impressive 24' tall. The Timber Tower is a modern approach to playground towers, with vertical cladding on each side along with stainless steel mesh panels for visibility into the structure (and to see the amazing views!). The ground level of Timber Tower 2 includes a Flexform ramp with attached Accoya boards for gripping. This provides an accessible route to the first platform. The tower has two slides, one at 6' and the other at 12' along with access into the tower via many different climbing types. A variety of options exist for play underneath the tower, adding more accessible opportunities for play.

Log Pile 3.1 has low levels but high challenge play opportunities that will help younger children build confidence and assess risk. The log beams create an open-ended challenge for little children. Keeping the littles in mind, we included the Junior Form Large Pine, a great climber for the 2-5 age group. This piece looks just like the mountains in the view from the park. It has three peaks and cut-outs for hands and feet that create light and shadow play on the inside. This encourages climbing and adventure!

For motion, we included we included our Leaf Wobble Board. This piece is a versatile take on rocking playground equipment that lets users sit or stand while wobbling.

Both the Timber Tower 2 structure and the Junior Form Large Pine are offered here with the stain option included.

This Earthscape option offers a commanding wooden structure that everyone will notice!















2D Renderings/Site Plan - Option B



Lifetime* Limited Warranty from date of invoice on steel support posts against structural failure due to corrosion, deterioration or manufacturing defects.

15 Year* Limited Warranty from date of invoice on all steel components, rails, loops, tubes, rungs, HDPE panels and components and aluminum connectors against structural failure due to corrosion, deterioration or manufacturing defects.

10 Year* Limited Warranty from date of invoice on all HDPE slides against breakage.

8 Year* Limited Warranty from date of invoice on all timber components against breakage.

5 Year* Limited Warranty from date of invoice on ropes, bamboo, polyethylene and rubber components against structural failure or defects in material or workmanship.

2 Year* Limited Warranty for all moving parts and bearings.

One Year Warranty* Berliner Seilfabrik warrants that all product or equipment purchased will be free from defects in workmanship or materials for one year from the date of invoice. Berliner Seilfabrik will repair or replace the parts of the product or equipment found to be defective free of charge.

*Items not covered in the above Warranties

Product or equipment that is not installed in conformity with installation instructions provided by Berliner Seilfabrik; product or equipment that has not been maintained and inspected in accordance with Berliner Seilfabrik's instructions; product or equipment that has been subjected to misuse, negligence or accident; product or equipment that has been subjected to addition, modification, alteration, repair, or part substitution by persons other than Berliner Seilfabrik or Berliner Seilfabrik's designees. Labor or damages resulting from vandalism, abnormal use, incorrect installation, and lack of maintenance are not covered by the above warranties. These warranties do not include any or all of the following cosmetic issues: scratches, dents, normal wear and tear, marring, deformation and cracking of timber and bamboo, fading of colors, discoloration, and natural fading. The above warranties are exclusive and lieu of all other warranties, whether expressed or implied, including, but not limited to any warranty of merchantability or fitness for a particular purpose. Further, no representation, oral or written, of any representative of Berliner Seilfabrik may be substituted for the afore described limited warranties. To the extent permitted by law, Berliner Seilfabrik shall not be liable, direct, indirect, special, incidental, or consequential damages which are expressly excluded from the above warranties.

This warranty excludes liability other than that expressly stated, including but not limited to any incidental or consequential damages.

*For the purpose of this warranty, the term lifetime encompasses no specific term of years, but rather that the seller warrants to its original customer for as long as the original customer owns the product and uses the product for its intended purpose that the product and all parts will be free from defects in material and manufacturing workmanship.

Warranty under Coastal or Chloric Conditions

Parts Replacement Warranty

Exclusions
